Landscapes provide the setting for your artwork. Not every piece needs to have them, but backgrounds like these can set the tone for your drawing before you even put the character in it. It grounds your characters, giving them something to interact with, even it they're just standing.

Landscapes also affect lighting: not just where the sun is, but light bouncing off elements around your character can tint them further.

Time for spooky **October!**Draw haunted imagery if you want, but I wanted to give you some variety with one of my favorite subjects: landscapes. This includes things we usually don't think of as landscapes, like cityscapes, ocean scenes, even underwater.

No need to stick to reality: creative scenes from fantasy can be very fun to draw and paint. But if you do want to be real, try some scenes in different seasons and think about the different colors to see.

Use plenty of reference photos! Studying landscapes from reference can be great exercises for perspective and general observational skills.
